Program overview

- You will be matched with a volunteer conversation partner
- You meet one-on-one with your volunteer
- Your meetings should be for one hour per week
- Your meetings can be in person or online

Program purpose

- To help you practise your conversational English
- To help you gain some Australian cultural insight

Volunteers

- Volunteers give their time and knowledge graciously to help you practise conversational English
- Volunteers come from a range of backgrounds. They are students or staff from the University of Adelaide, or people from the community including retired or semi-retired people
- All volunteers are competent speakers and writers of English
- All volunteers have joined the program because they are interested in helping someone from another culture to practise conversational English
- Volunteers are not paid for their participation in the program – they help out because they enjoy it
